Energy Saver

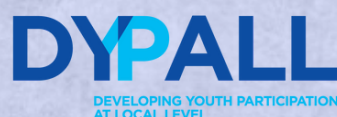
Turn off one electronic device or light in the room to save energy.

Green Thumb

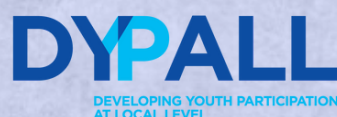
Plant a seed in a small pot or cup (use a bean or any seed available).

Eco-friendly Fashion

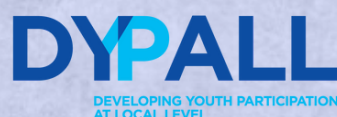
Name three ways to make your wardrobe more eco-friendly (like buying second-hand clothes or washing in cold water).
